What Is A Construction Hoarding Sign?

A construction hoarding is a large temporary wall that is put up around a construction site to shield the public from what is going on at the site. Construction hoardings are put up around:

- New building sites
- Buildings that are being repaired or renovated
- Rental units inside buildings such as shopping malls

It is a temporary structure that is taken down once the new building or storefront is complete.

Materials

Construction hoardings are usually a series of interlocking panels made of painted drywall or plywood. A printed custom graphic is applied to the visible surface. The panels are meant to be temporary so they are designed to be easily put up and taken down.

An open construction site can be a dangerous place for an unsuspecting passerby. A construction hoarding sign can protect anyone who is driving or walking past a construction site from getting hit by any loose debris or objects that might be flying around the site during construction.

The suspense of what the new building is going to look like can make you excited to finally see the end project. Placing an attractive sign on a construction hoarding can help to build the suspense for your potential customers and make them excited for the final reveal.

The sheer size of most construction hoardings also makes them an amazing canvas on which you can display eye-catching graphics and copy that can be easily seen from a great distance.
